The next order of business was the launch calendar for 2015. This can be found on page 5 of this newsletter. Several changes or additions were made including moving our first high power launch from March to April to possibly avoid the weather that has plagued that event recently (the season will begin in Hutch with a sport launch), the possible addition of a launch coordinated with the Rush County 4H group in LaCrosse, Ks, the addition of a third high power launch in Ellinwood called Rocket-tober, dropping the Low and Slow event and ending the year with NightFlight in November as we did this year. For the first time at an annual meeting, we also set the location for next years meeting, that being the Palmer home in Hutchinson, Ks.

Next, in near record time we set the events for our annual contest KRAMO 35. These events can be found on page 6 of this issue under the heading "It's Never to Early."

Traci Ross was selected as our Jr. NAR sponsored candidate. With a smile of unbelief Dennis Elder received a Level One kit designed and packaged by President Keith Ravenstein. This is the same basic kit which has been used successfully by two previous KOMSOnaut's to gain their Level One ticket. Duane Lanterman bought one of Keith's kits to make into his first dual deploy model later this year. I believe Keith still has one kit in stock if you'd like to contact him. It is suitable for Level One or Two flights.

Several motor orders were placed through Keith and will be delivered at the April launch and the business meeting was called to a close about 3pm.

The "show and tell" portion of the meeting began with Steve Saner showing his recently purchased Archetype Rockets cable cutter and how it works. Keith Ravenstein then showed his modified router table that has been made into a very cool and practical tool for making bulkheads and centering rings. John Palmer had brought two recently finished models a V2 and a Bullpup. Duane Lanterman displayed his Estes Dark Silver which he received as a promo at last years NARAM. Steve Saner had two scratch built models, one was a fairly common Pringles can conversion, the other a little more unique. Steve had found one of those "noodles" kids use at the swimming pool along the road. Why not make it into a rocket was his first thought! The inside of the noodle just happened to be 29mm so a tube was inserted inside and Steve made a solid wood nose cone on his lathe. Pretty cool!

That wrapped up the meeting for the year. Here's to calm winds and clear skies as the 2015 season begins.



IT'S NEVER TO EARLY - KRAMO 35 EVENTS

This is going to be hard to believe, but our 35th edition of our NAR sanctioned contest we call KRAMO is happening this spring. Set for June 13-14 at our field at the Kansas State Fairgrounds this should be something special. I know you are thinking that the middle of June is a long way off. I can wait and build my contest models in the motel room the night before you say. (trust me this happens more than you might imagine). A better strategy might be to start now, while the snow is still on the ground. (or its 70 degrees outside, what a crazy Winter this has been) So to get you going here is a list of the events for KRAMO 35.

OPEN SPOT LANDING
PREDICTED DURATION
"B" EGGLOFT DURATION
"1/2A" SUPER ROC DURATION
"A" HELICOPTER DURATION
"A" BOOST GLIDER DURATION

Here are some special notes on the events above. Your "call" on predicted duration must be between 30 seconds and 50 seconds. In the egglofting event due to safety concerns at our field, a TOWER style launcher will be allowed for the event ONLY if the body tube has a UNIFORM diameter (not tapered). The exception would be that a tapered diameter body can be use in the tower but a piston launcher must also be incorporated into that tower.

We are organizing as a Regional contest. If we do not reach the number of participants to be a Regional we will downgrade to an OPEN meet and drop "A" Helicopter from the official events. We will still fly the helicopter event for prizes but this events results would not effect the overall winner and points would not be submitted to the NAR.

If you haven't flown contest events before check out the Pink Book on the NAR website or check the KRAMO link at www.kosmo427.org and there find a link for each event to be held and the rules. KRAMO has been dubbed the "fun contest" and the atmosphere is low key. It's a great first contest or a great 35th contest. Come on out and have fun. There is also sport flying both days so everyone can get in on the act. Put it on your calendar and we will see you there!!
